RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND AWARDING CONTRACTS FOR THE EMERGENCY REPLACEMENT OF A CHANNEL GRINDER IN THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT OF THE BOROUGH OF ROOSEVELT

WHEREAS, the Borough of Roosevelt, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") owns and operates a wastewater treatment system as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15; and
WHEREAS, on or about January 10, 2018, the Borough Engineer determined that the channel grinder in the Borough's wastewater treatment plant was not working properly and required immediate repair and replacement; and
WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer advised that failing to immediately replace the channel grinder in the Borough's wastewater treatment plant would create an emergency affecting the public health, safety and welfare of the Borough's residents; and
WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, the Borough's Mayor advised the Borough's Purchasing Agent in writing of the nature and necessity of an emergency contract to replace the channel grinder in the Borough's wastewater treatment plant, which written notification is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and
WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer was able to obtain a quote from JWC Environmental in the amount of \$14,759.55 to immediately order a new channel grinder for the Borough's wastewater treatment plant, which quote is attached hereto as Exhibit B; and
WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer was able to obtain a quote from EDC Electric in the amount of \$4,000.00 for the removal and replacement of the channel grinder in the Borough's wastewater treatment plant, which quote is attached hereto as Exhibit C; and
WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, the Borough is authorized to award contracts for goods and services without public advertising for bids and bidding therefor, regardless of whether or not

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6.1, the Borough was authorized to award a contract in the amount of \$14,759.55 to JWC Environmental to immediately order a new channel grinder for the Borough's wastewater treatment plant insofar as it was impracticable to obtain any other competitive quotations, notwithstanding that said contract is more than 15% of, but less than the \$17,500 bid threshold; and

the contract price will exceed the bid threshold, when an emergency affecting the public health, safety or

Treasury of the State of New Jersey under their statutory authority, the bid threshold is currently \$17,500;

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3, as adjusted by the Governor and Department of the

welfare requires the immediate delivery of goods or the performance of services; and

and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6.1, the Borough was authorized to award a contract in the amount of \$4,000.00 to EDC Electric to immediately for the removal and replacement of the channel grinder in the Borough's wastewater treatment plan insofar as it was impracticable to obtain any other competitive quotations, notwithstanding that said contract is more than 15% of, but less than the \$17,500 bid threshold; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding any of the foregoing, the Borough is authorized, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(gg), to award contracts to EDC Electric and JWC Environmental without public advertising for bids and bidding therefor, regardless of whether or not the contract price will exceed the bid threshold, because said contracts relate to the designing, financing, construction, operation, maintenance, or any combination thereof, or any component or parts of a wastewater treatment system, as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15;
