### Dear John Holden:

A review of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department), Bureau of Safe Drinking Water (Bureau) records indicates that your system qualifies for lead and copper (PBCU) annual monitoring. Samples collected between 05/07/2019-05/13/2019 (1st half 2019) and 09/14/2019-09/18/2019 (2nd half 2019) confirmed that PBCU results were below their respective action levels at the 90th percentile. In addition, criteria set forth in the Fact Sheet for Reduced Lead and Copper Monitoring Requirements for Public Water Systems (https://www.state.nj.us/dep/watersupply/pdf/lead-reduced-monitoring-fs.pdf) was met. Therefore, the sampling frequency for PBCU is being reduced to once per year in accordance with 40 CFR 141.86 (c) & (d)(4)(i).

Lead and copper sampling is next due in 2020, with sample collection occurring between June 1<sup>st</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup>. The number of samples required for each system is based on the population served. Bureau records indicate that your system's residential population is 880 persons. A minimum of 10 PBCU samples are required to be sampled.

The reduced number of samples must be taken from the approved pool of targeted sampling sites utilized during initial. When selecting reduced PBCU sites, please refer to the Fact Sheet: Protocol for a Public Water System Selecting Reduced Lead and Copper Tap Sites (<a href="https://www.nj.gov/dep/watersupply/pdf/lead-reduced-sites-fs.pdf">https://www.nj.gov/dep/watersupply/pdf/lead-reduced-sites-fs.pdf</a>). If your initial sampling only consisted of 5 sites, those same sites must be sampled.

If the lead and/or copper action levels are exceeded in the future, your system must resume standard semi-annual (6-month) monitoring and take appropriate follow-up actions to comply with the applicable action level in accordance with 40 CFR 141.80 et seq.
