

1/3/24 MESSAGE FROM JCP&L

JCP&L is planning upgrades to its existing transmission lines to enhance electric service reliability and provide additional capacity to accommodate growing customer demand.

I wanted to provide the town notification that as part of the environmental permitting process for this work, JCP&L will be accessing its existing transmission right-of-way (see below graph). Our easement rights allow us to access the right-of-way without notice, but we're providing you information on our upcoming activities should you receive inquiries from residents. Surveys are expected to begin around January 22, 2024.

To ensure compliance with environmental regulations, our survey crews will drive or walk along the right-of-way, take measurements, hand place boundary flags and occasionally obtain small soil and/or vegetation samples. In addition, cultural surveys may require hand digging (holes approximately one foot in diameter) and screening soils to determine if any artifacts exist. Some larger geotechnical boring equipment may be used to obtain underground samples. Please note that soil and sod moved during these tests will be returned to the excavated area.
